Ms. Julie Chiu outlined the structure of the campus of University of Southern California (USC), with students representing 135 countries around the world. Ms. Chiu also talked about the campus life. where students live near or on the campus. Incoming students stay in houses in residential college and are guaranteed housing for their first two years of studies. 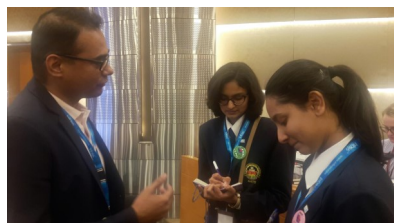
