The device gives them a 3D aural environment to create mental pictures while reading. He was recognized as the winner in the Individual Category. He was presented with Gold Medal, Certificate of Excellence, a cash reward of Rs. 50,000, and a return trip to Washington, D.C. in May 2017. He will now represent India in the global felicitation ceremonies for The Spirit of Community Award winners from all participating countries. Programme Ambassador, Saina Nehwal, Olympic Medalist and Former World No.1 Badminton Player, was present at the occasion to encourage the finalists. Reading Mahotsava

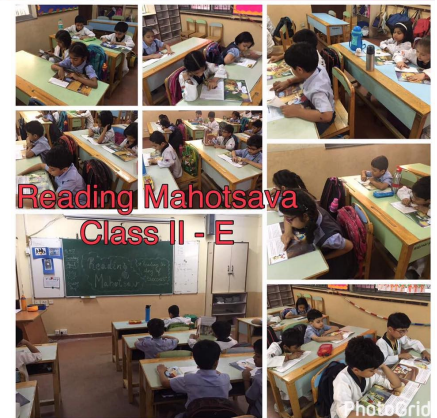
