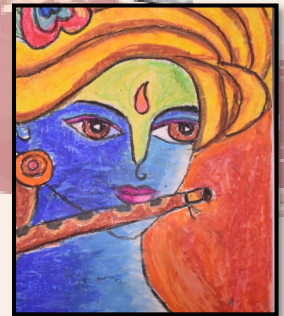
EXAM STRESS

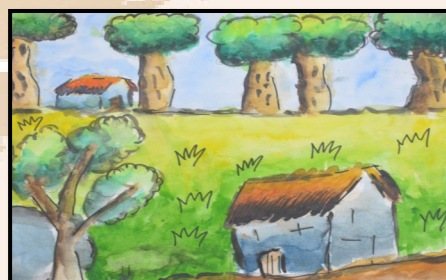

THE NEW YEAR EVE

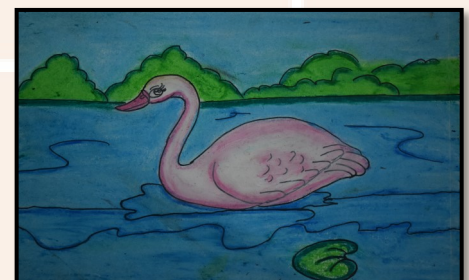
The New Year's Eve is the day,
