I look at it like time has flown.

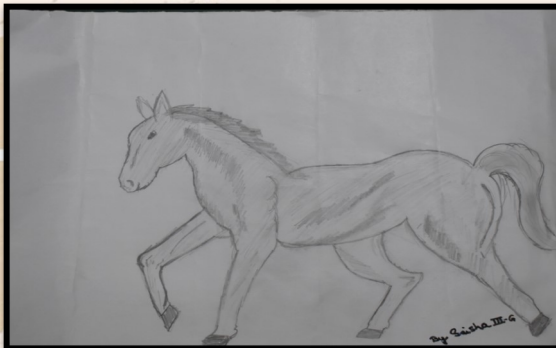

sight.

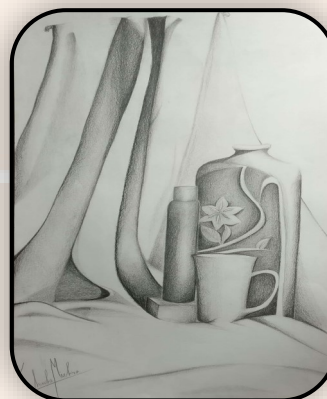
For the past infinite years,

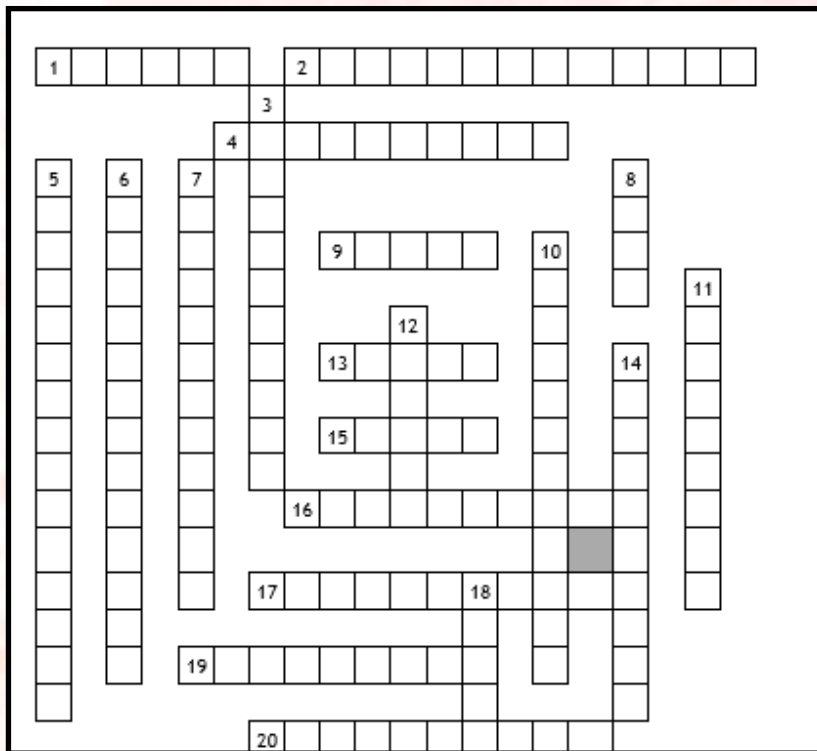

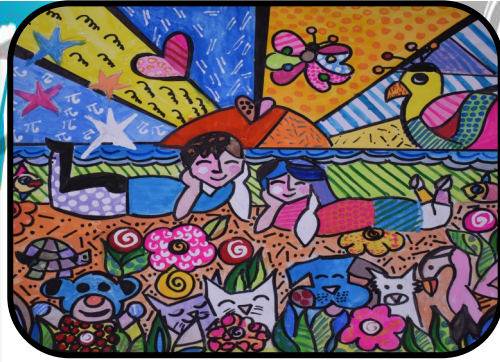
