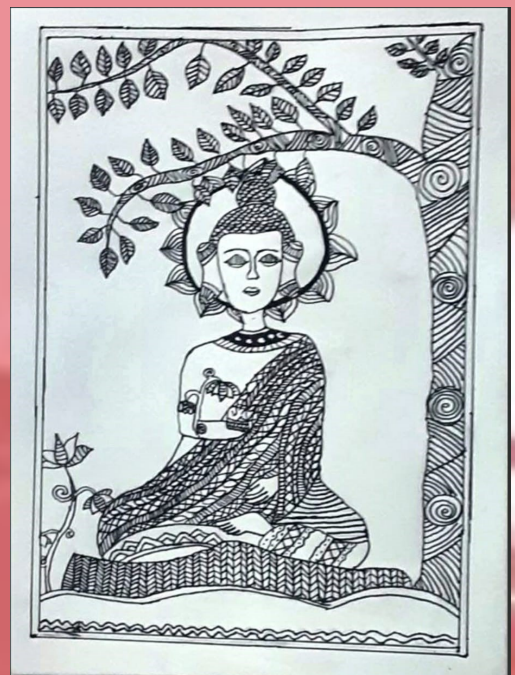

But I love to sit back and enter a world of imagination.

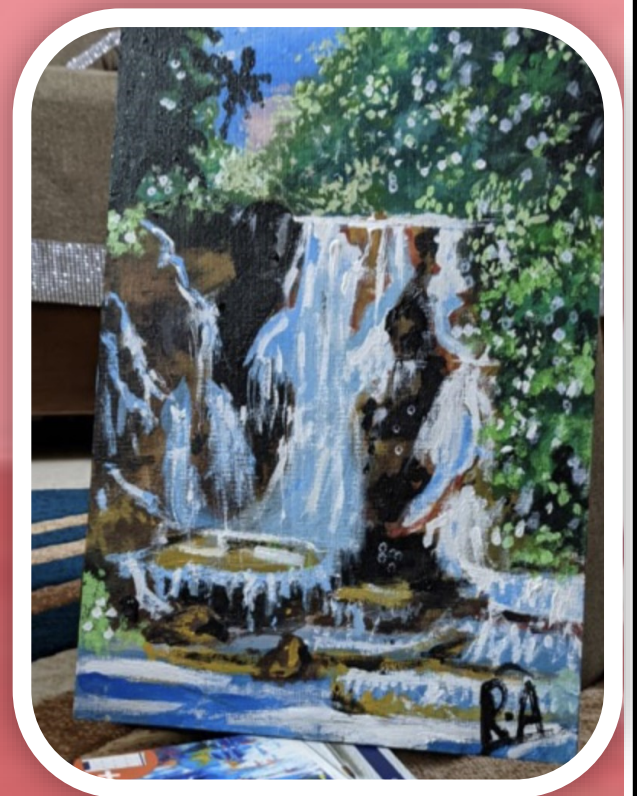

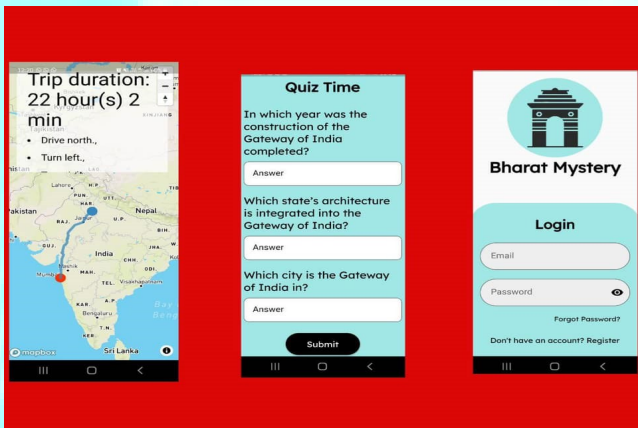
INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY REPORTS

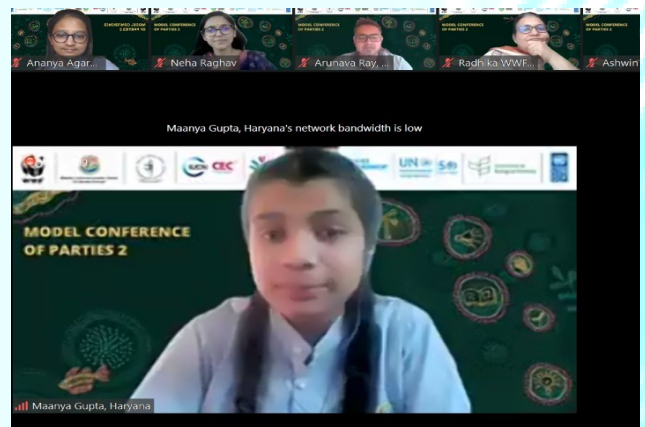
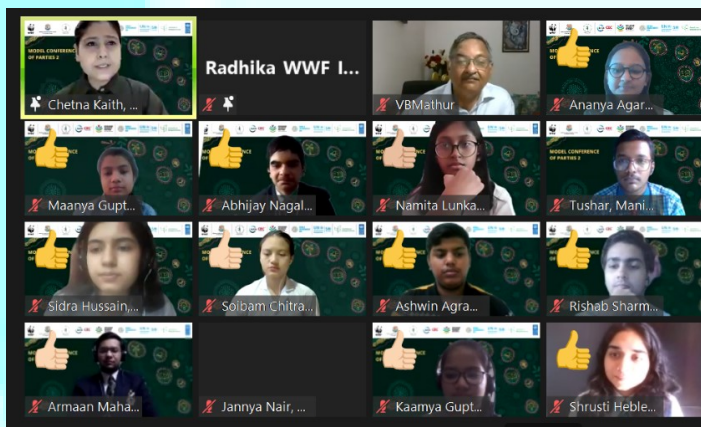


REPORTS

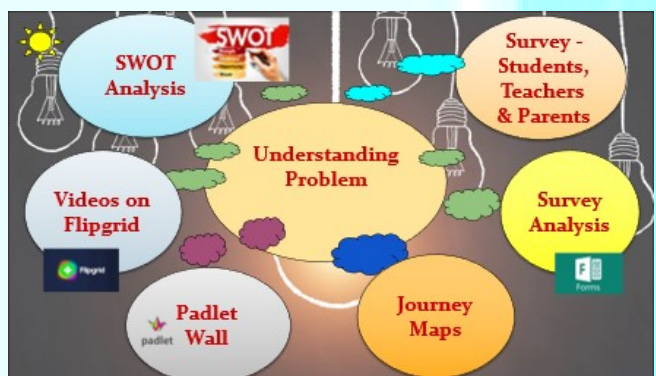
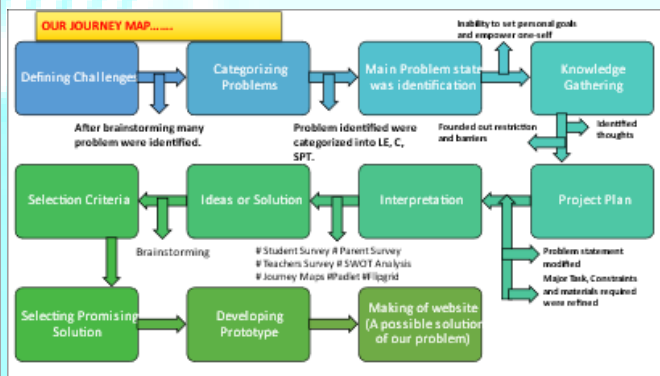


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DESIGN THINKING WORKSHOP

In this VUCA times when everyone is experiencing new set of problems and needs different approach to design a solution, a 6-day Design Thinking Workshop by Mr Ramprakash (and his team) from Qatapult Learning Solutions Pvt. Ltd. was conducted from 1st June to 7th June for all Amity Schools.

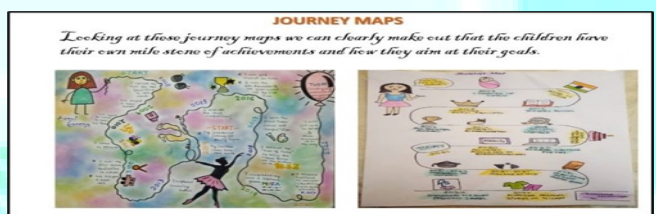
The workshop aimed at empowering teachers and schools to look into the problem areas during the current pandemic condition and online sessions and through step-by-step guidance of processes, design a prototype solution that caters to the need of all its stakeholders. The entire program was well crafted in stages Along with learning about processes a lot of insight into different components of problem were learnt- *empathizing with the users, understanding the challenges, defining the problem statement, looking into barriers, change in mindsets* enabled us to redefine our problem statement. At Amity design thinking is a very inclusive part of the curriculum and project-based activities yet it was a milestone in learning for it empowered us with more insight. All the teams had to present their prototype solutions and our team (**G46 + RPR**) created the website **GOALS- Great Odyssey for AMITY Leadership for Students**, with feedback and its implementation as well. We used various IT tools to collect data – Padlet, Flipgrid, Journey Maps, SWOT analysis, Self-assessment tests, Surveys for students, parents and teachers were also conducted and all this data was compiled to shape up the solution. We also created a **Phone Buddy App** for students to collate their achievements. This gave the team members a lot of confidence and a feeling of pride as we could successfully apply what we learnt during the workshop and relate well with the problem of students in current times.

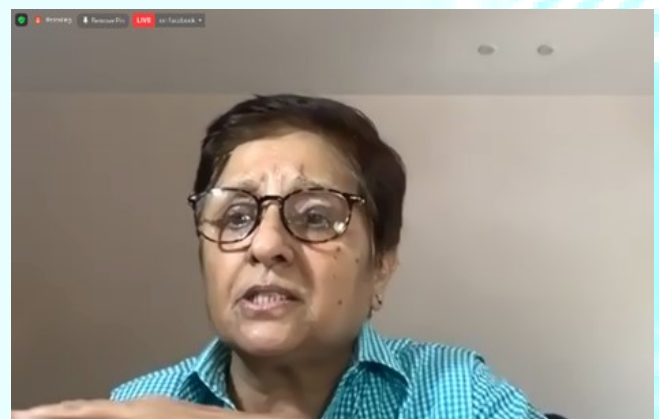
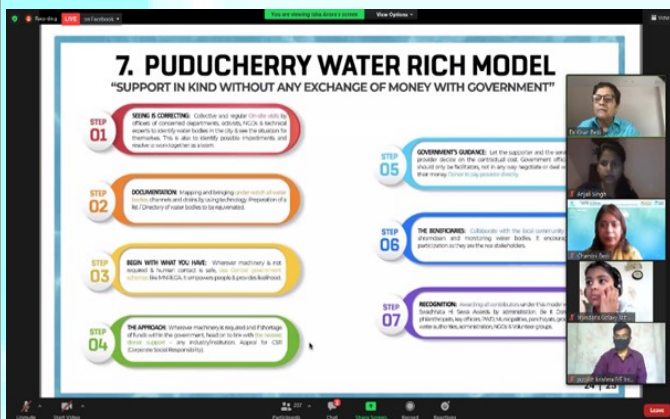

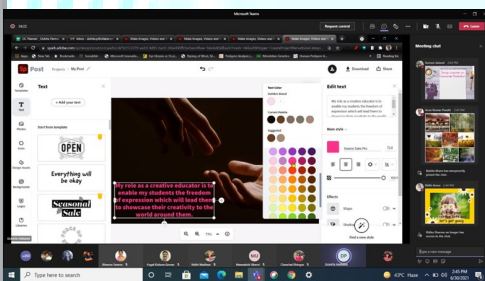
OPEN SESSION WITH DR. KIRAN BEDI ON WATER AWARENESS- CATCH THE RAIN

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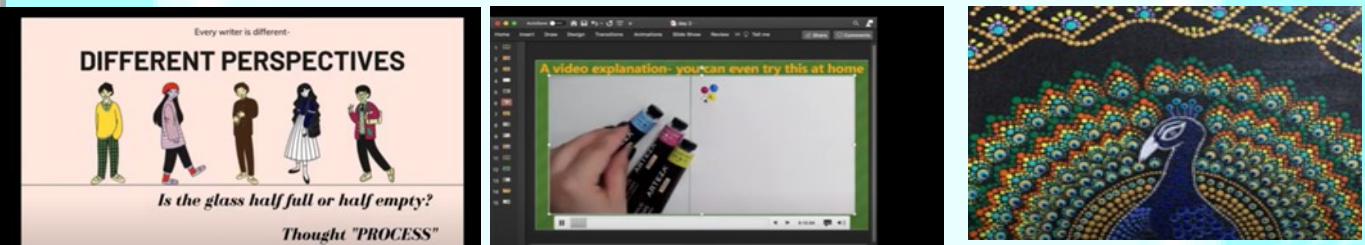
SUMMER HORIZON CLUBS 2021-22
