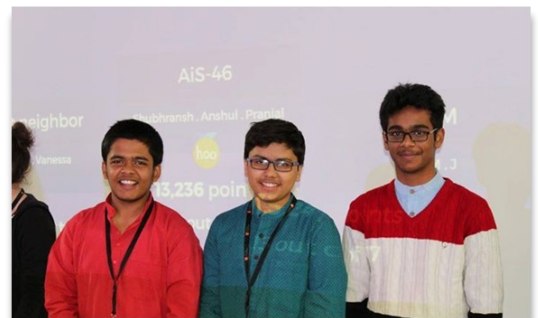
## YRONS 2017
