CHAIRPERSON'S MESSAGE



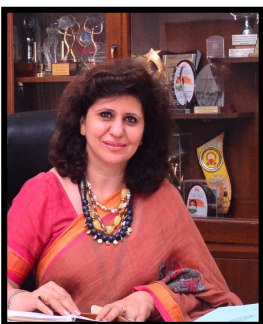
Dear Amitians,

Dear Readers,

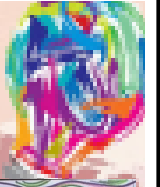

AMITY'S BUDDING WRITERS

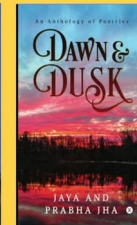

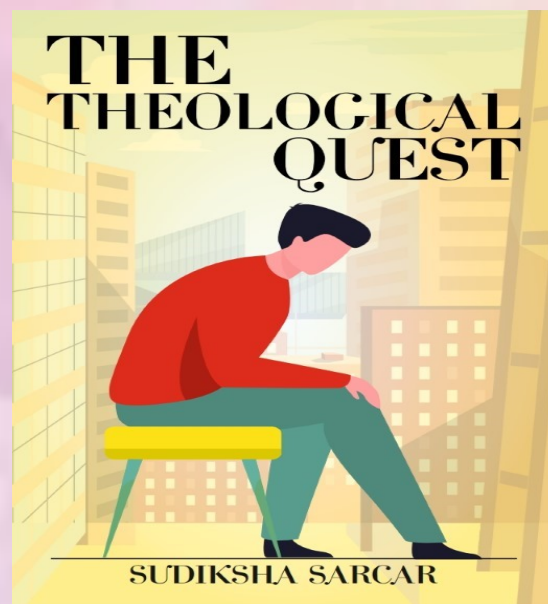

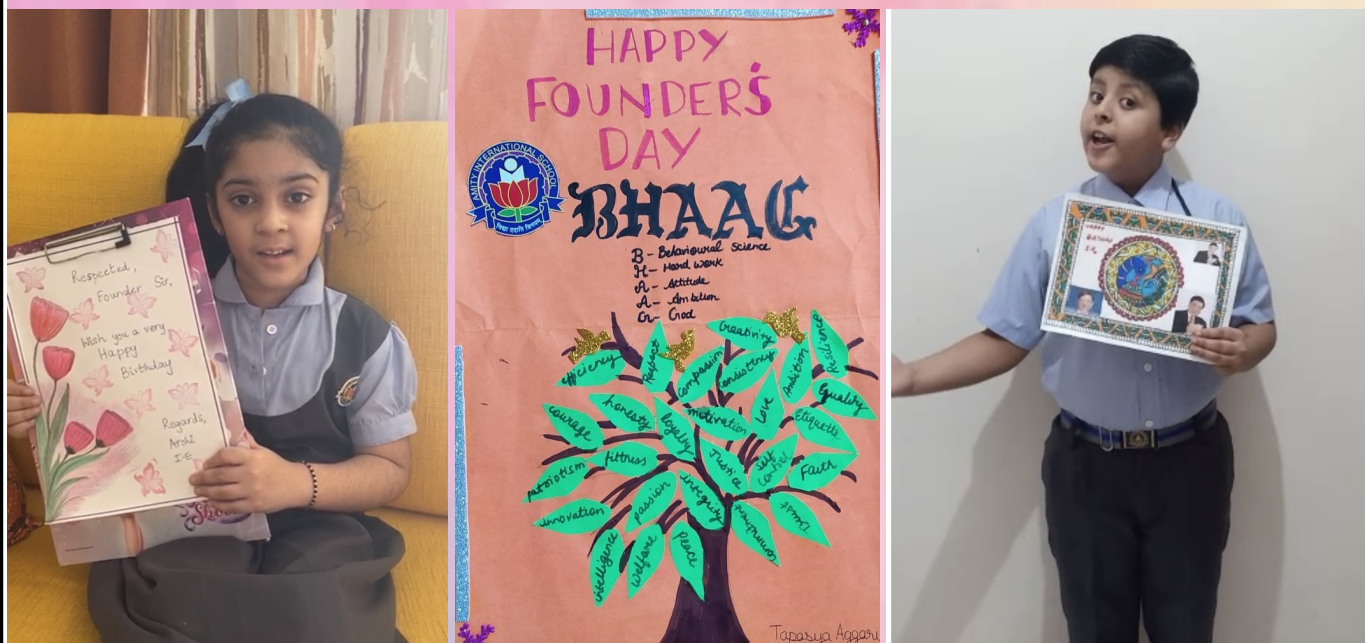

HARYANA DAY CELEBRATION

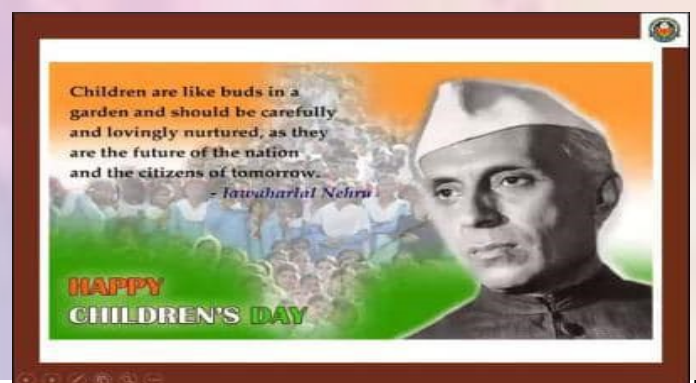
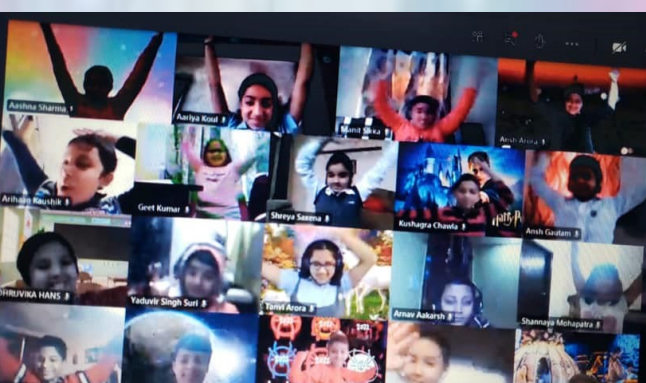

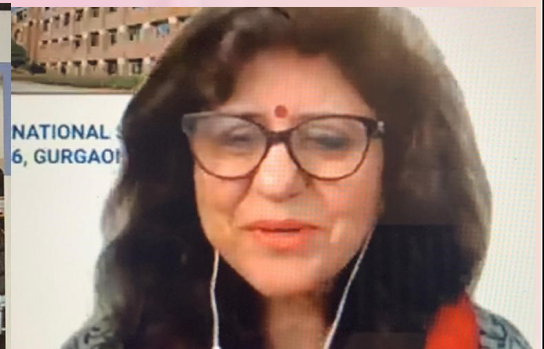
AMIOWN PARENT VIRTUAL PRE—ORIENTATION GRADE I
