- 1. Tanmay is world's youngest IBM Watson Programmer.
- 2. He started coding at the age of five
- 3. He set up a YouTube channel when he was seven to post tutorials about web development and coding
- 4. He finished his first iOS/ Apple at the age of nine
- 5. At the age of 11 he uploaded his Video on YouTube about Artificial Intelligence

Hosted a TEDs Talk and became speaker at IBM Watson summits around the world

Master Tanmay Bakshi spoke about AI, Neural Network and Algorithms. The ted talk was followed by Q/A round where the students of Noida University asked questions about Quantum Computing, use of Maths in Computers etc. The entire event was witnessed at AIS46 by students of Class 8, 11 &12. The students found the
