Our team got a fabulous opportunity to interact with the Consul Mr. Ashish Gupta and the Deputy Consul General Mr. C Ramachandran.

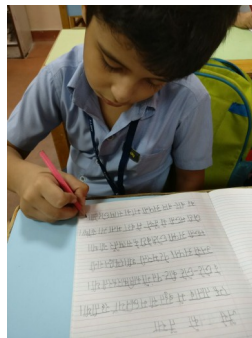
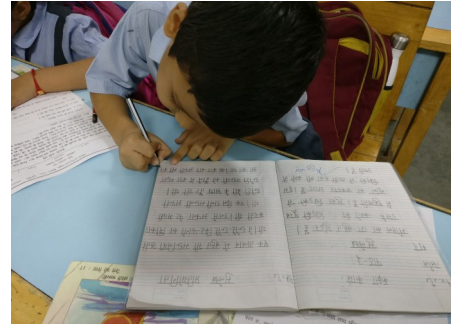
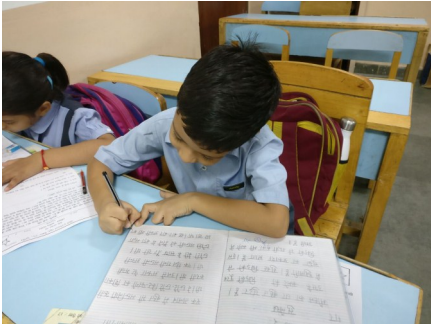
