HOT SHOT CHEF


Hot Shot Chef As summer approaches, every child is excited to have cool lick lollies.

Here I present very simple, easy to make Khatti Meethi lick lollies that you can enjoy with your friends and family.

Ingredients (For 4 Lick Iollies)

- 1. Toffees/ Candies of two different flavor (Strawberry/ Kaccha Aam) 10 pieces of each flavor
- 2. Powdered Sugar 6 teaspoons
- 3. Black Salt one pinch
- 4. Lemon 1 piece
- 5. Water 200ml
- 6. Lolly moulds





- Step 2 Keep the bowls aside till the toffees/ candies dissolve completely.
- Step 3 Add Sugar, few drops of lemon and black salt to the above mix.
- Step 4 Pour one flavor in lolly mould till its half-filled.
- Step 5 Freeze the lolly mould till it's completely set.
- Step 6 Pour the other flavor in the lolly mould and cover it with the lid.
- Step 7 Freeze the lolly mould again. Step 8 your delicious khatti meethi lick lolly is ready to be serve


RHYTHMIC RAAGA

SUMMER HORIZON CLUBS 2022-23




















WORLD BRAIN DAY

Under the able guidance of Dr. (Mrs.) Amita Chauhan and dynamic leadership of school principal Ms. Arti Chopra, Amity International School, Sector 46 Gurugram celebrated World Brain Day on 22nd July 2022. It was dedicated to bring more attention to the importance of human brain in health and disease. Two renowned doctors from the Artemis Hospital Gurgaon graced the occasion. Dr. Sweetha Susanne Mohan (Sr. Consultant, Neuroanaesthesia and Neuro Critical Care) and Dr. Manish Mahajan (Sr. Consultant - Neurology & Head — Neuroimmunology) took a workshop with senior students and guided them how to promote positive mental health and reduce exams related stress and various types of headaches.

Both the doctors talked about precautions to take during severe headaches and discussed the primary and secondary headaches at length with curious pupils. With the help pf a power point presentation, they also talked about measures to be taken during a seizure and precautions to be followed if someone becomes unconscious. The question and answer session by the doctors cleared all the doubts of students and promoted public awareness about neurological disorders and the strategies to prevent them.


YOUTH POWER AWARDS- 2021-22
