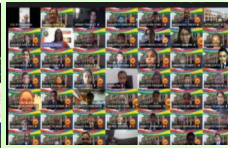
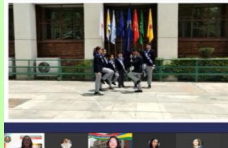
Dear Students,

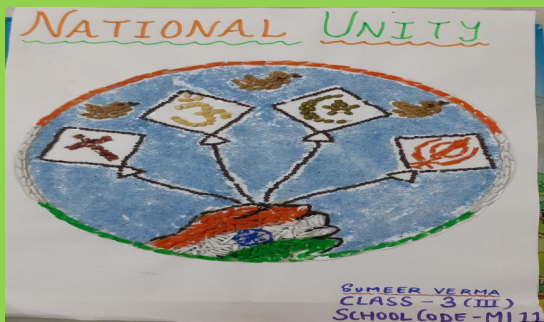

ONAM Festival - Ishaan Jain 2A

Amity international school, Mayur Vihar, organized a wonderful event - 'Monsoon Mania', where the students showcased various festivals that are celebrated, to welcome monsoon, in various parts of India. I was dressed as a tiger and depicted Onam, I showcased a special dance form called tiger dance, which is traditionally performed during Onam.

Onam is a monsoon harvest festival , celebrated in Kerala, during the months of August/ September, in the honor of a demon king Mahabali.

People wear traditional clothes. The women wear a special traditional saree called Kasavu saree. They make colorful flower rangolis called pookkalam, cook traditional feasts known as sadhya. Onam sadhya is a 9 -course meal and consists of 26 items. People also take part in boat races and dance performances.

One special dance performance which we showcased was tiger dance. Also known as Pulikkali, it is celebrated on the fourth day of onam. The participants paint their body in really bright colors to resemble tigers, using red, yellow and black paints and dance to the beat of musical instruments.

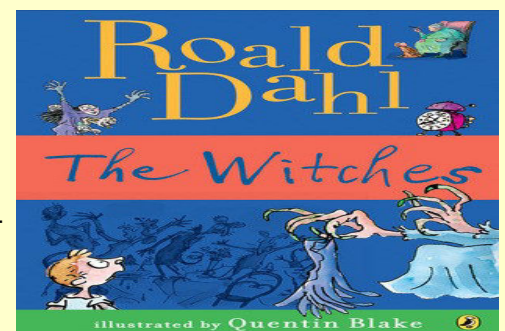
BOOK REVIEW

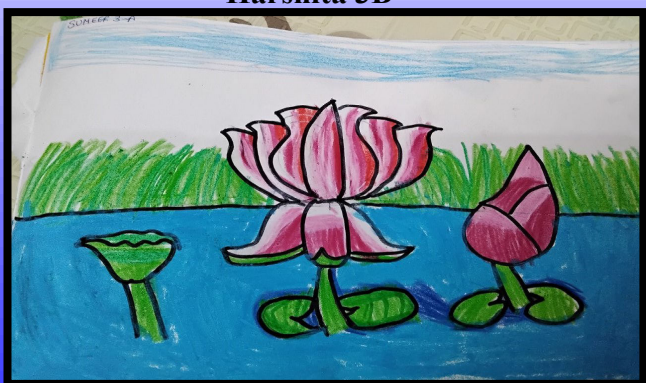

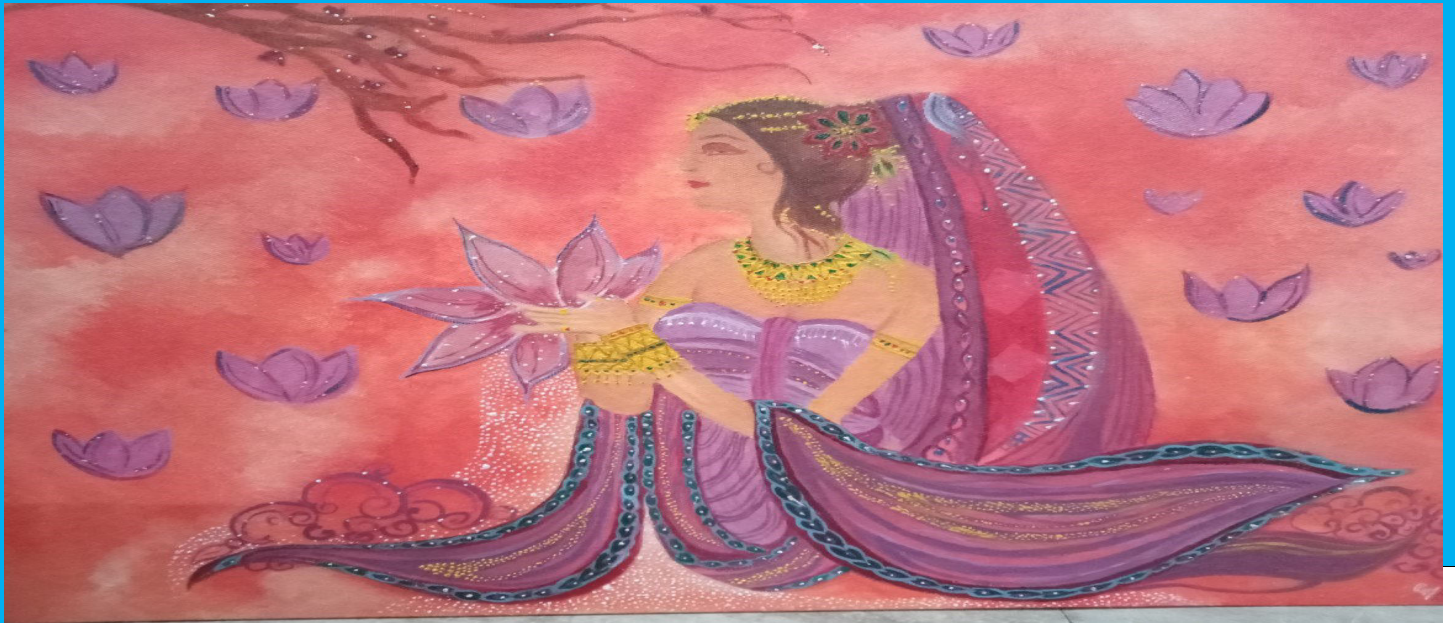

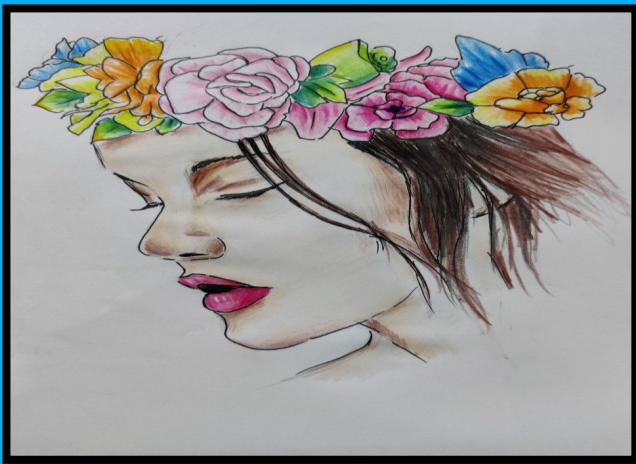

TESSERACT 2021 ATL FEST

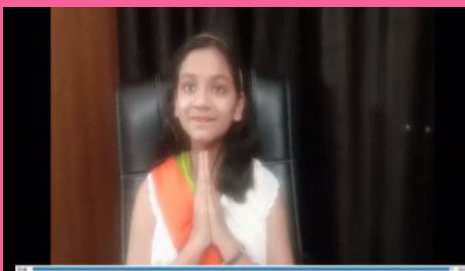

CLASS 4 PRESENTATION

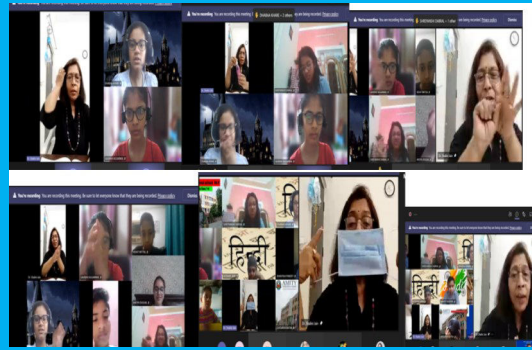

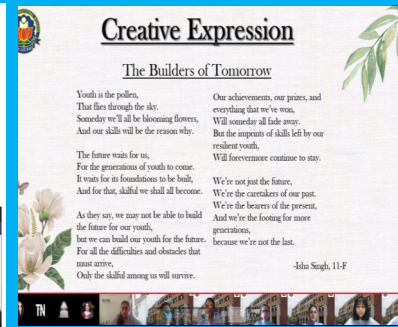

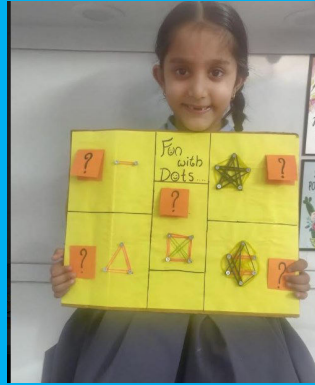
