Is it New Year?

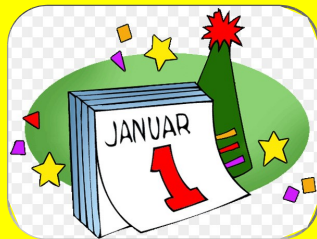
*It's 11:30 and everyone is awake,

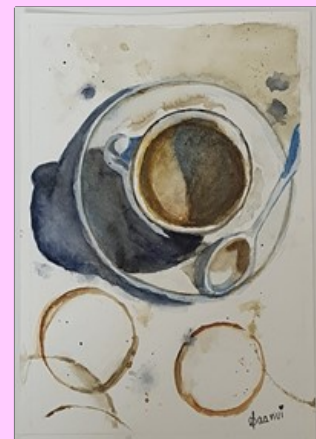
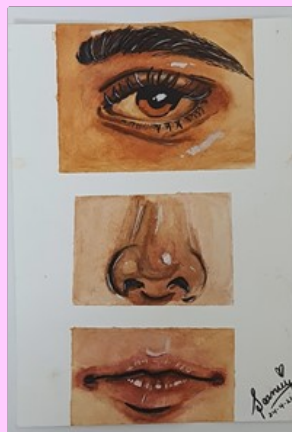

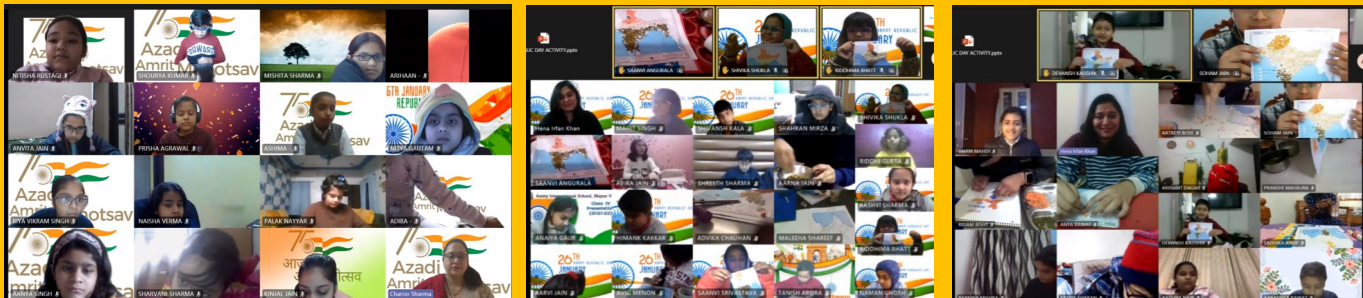


UNITY IN DIVERSITY- MAP ACTIVITY, CLASS IV

SPRING IS BACK

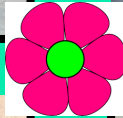
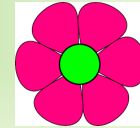
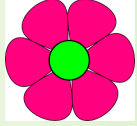
*“Without children, tomorrow wouldn’t be worth the wait;

The total number of students on the first day was 66 and it was a huge and happy turnout. The teachers took their regular classes and it was a thrilling experience for all to be back in the offline classroom.



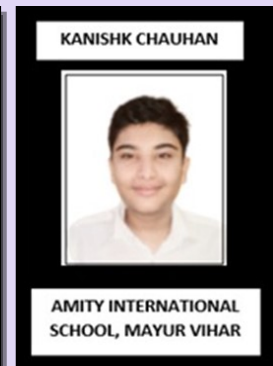

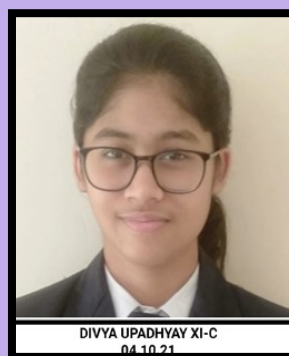

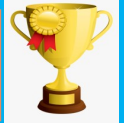
DHANANJAY MOHAN ATL INNOVATION FEST 2021

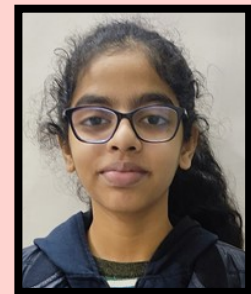
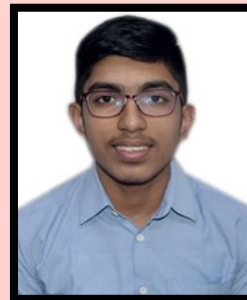

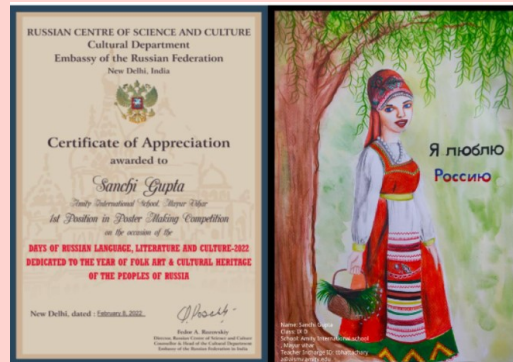
