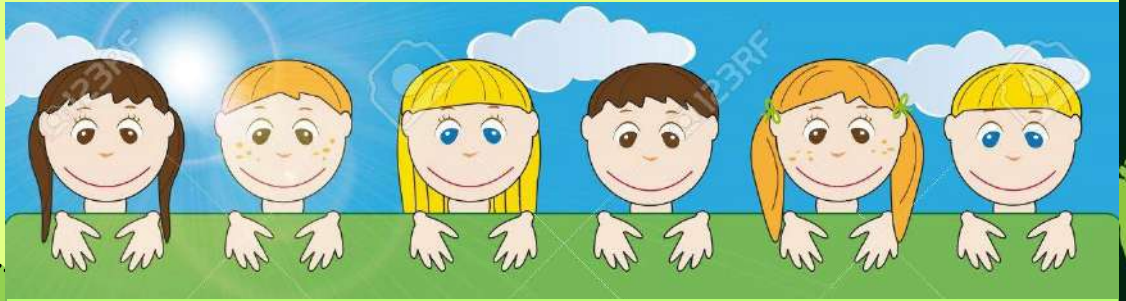

Let's just pledge to take care of every hedge.

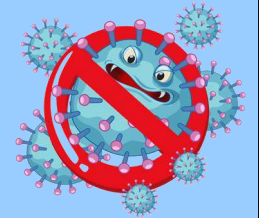

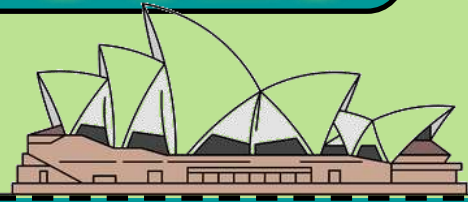

My favourite place in Australia is Melbourne, the city and its suburbs one of the best places to stay in the world.

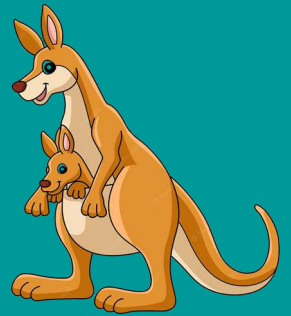
My favourite memory from the trip is going to **Rottneest Island** by ferry. As I see Whales, Quakka and different kinds of fishes.

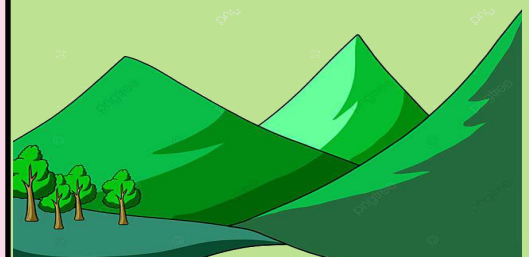

RECIPES

Step 3 - Take the ketchup and spread it on the second slice of bread.

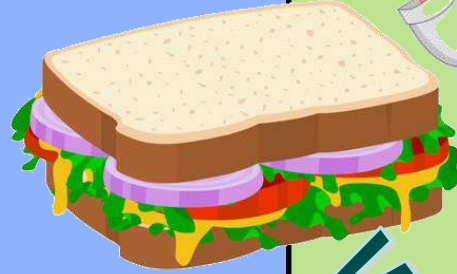
Step 4 - Take slices of tomatoes and place it on the first slice of bread.

AAM PANNA



- *Take 4 raw mangoes
- *Peel them and cut them into pieces
- *Add 4 cup water and pressure cook it for 5 minutes.
- *Then cool the cooked mangoes and blend it.
- *Add 400 gm sugar to it and give it a boil in the cooker.
- *Add 1 tablespoon jeera powder
- *1 table spoon black salt
- *1 table spoon Pudina powder
- *1/4th tea spoon black pepper.
- *Salt to taste and give it a boil for 3minutes.
- *Store this pulp in a bottle and refrigerate.

Drink each time by filling 3/4th glass with pulp and rest with water and ice.
