




INSPIRE AWARDS - MANAK


Nurturing Philanthropy For A Better Tomorrow




VIRTUAL ORIENTATION





















UNINESH 2021

A Revelation Of The Nation's Birth


The journey to India's independence did not have an easy path. Several people sacrificed their lives for the country and many suffered to seek freedom.







The Janmashtami celebration showcased important phases or incidents from the life of Lord Krishna which was titled "Krishna Madhurima".








AMITY MODEL UN 2021

Quantum Steps To Cosmic Victories







Dr. Richa Pandey, Mr. Sandeep Kaushik and Mr. Devendra Kumar were the mentors for the participating teams.










ATL MARATHON

QUIZZAT 2021


A Test Of Prompt And Erudite Minds







INVESTITURE CEREMONY



Books, not looks!

Remember Mrs. Wormwood from the popular classic Matilda? The one who said "You chose books. I chose looks." Yes, one of the most iconic dialogues in the book is the bitter reality of today's times. For the past few centuries, we have defined beauty not by happiness, health, and personality but by physical appearance. The majority of people in today's times judge each other -- and even themselves, sometimes -- based on how they look. The physical appearance of a person is a major contributing factor to the social status and popularity of a person. We are born with an eye for beauty, but our society nurtures that preference by rewarding attractiveness. And I think it's a shame. Looks attract but fade, while personality keeps. When we meet someone for the first time, and make a judgment based on their external appearance, our judgment may be wrong. It is just like a wrapper on chocolate or a gift-wrap. Unless and until you don't remove the wrapper you cannot guess what is in the package. After consuming or using the product only then can you judge whether you have got true value for the product. A few encounters will enable us to understand the person. It's better to stay neutral until the moment when you can say for sure that you know this or that person well enough to say that they are a person who do or don't deserve faith, understanding and attention. So never judge people by appearances, because appearances can be deceptive. Some of the decent-looking people behave in an odd way, while some others unseen, behave very well. Therefore, it is not possible to judge a person by his/her external looks. George Bernard Shaw and Shakespeare were not perceived to be handsome. But their writings have portrayed their high intellect. The great writer Helen Keller may not have been considered a beautiful lady. She was deprived of sight, hearing impaired, unable to speak when she was just a two-year-old child. But fighting all odds, she had become a celebrity author! Contrary to this, Walt Disney was not only handsome but had an international reputation by his steadfast work, devotion, and dedication. Imagine a situation where a posh black SUV arrives, and a handsome man dressed in a suit with polished shoes gets out of the car. The first immediate impression? This man is a rich, successful businessman and can be trusted. But, what if he turns out to be nothing more than a cheat and liar? Your ideas and thoughts about a person or object should not be based on what you see, usually things like how the person or object looks physically, what they wear, what they act like, etc. Something can be very different inside than it is on the outside. Often we base our ideas on something when we first see it. Like if one fruit looks more undamaged or fresh than another, most people would immediately think that the better-looking fruit is the better fruit, even if inside, the good-looking fruit has a fruit worm. A person may look lazy but can work very hard and with efficacy when motivated. I would like to conclude by saying "Sometimes people are beautiful. Not in looks. Not in what they say. Just in what they are."
