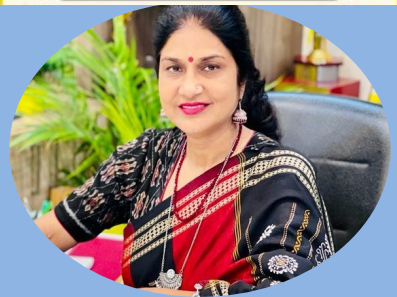

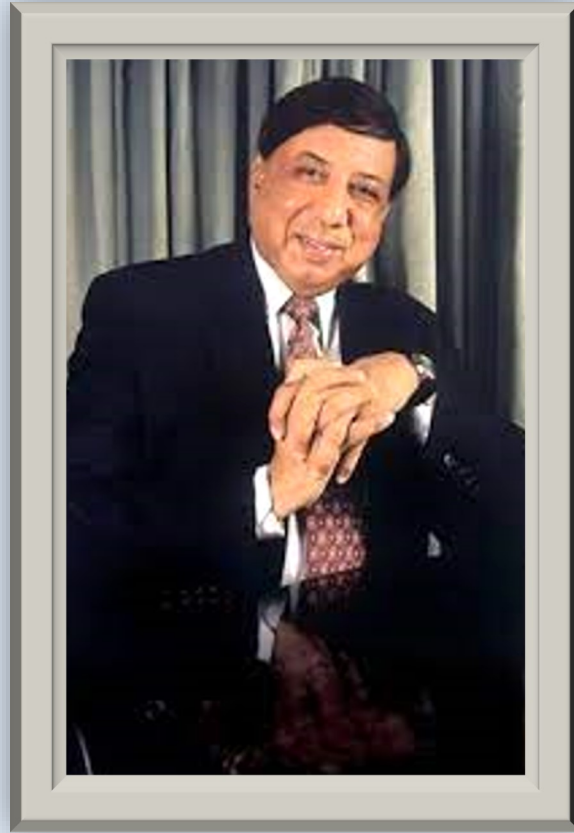

- 2) Ms. Shivani Shah - Co-founder and CEO of AccesAble Places which is an app - based community making navigation easier for the disabled at various public places.

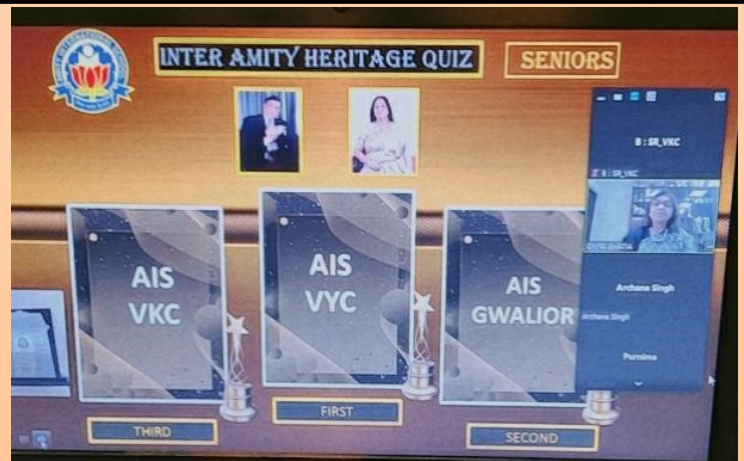
- 3) Dr. N.L. Senthil Kumar - CEO of Association of People
